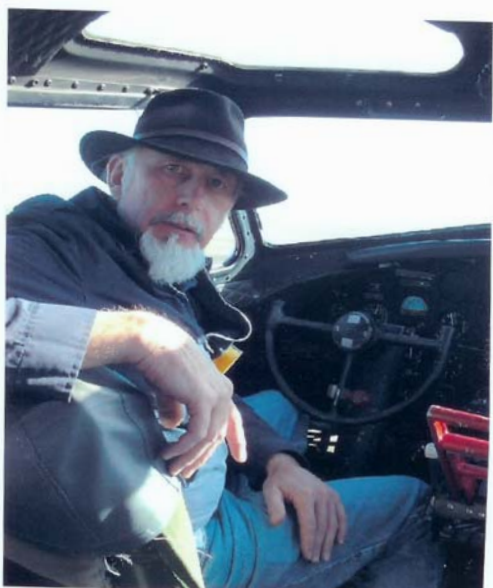

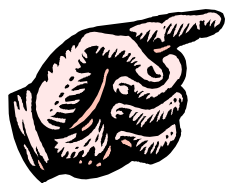
## Volunteers Needed
